➤ **Constraints**

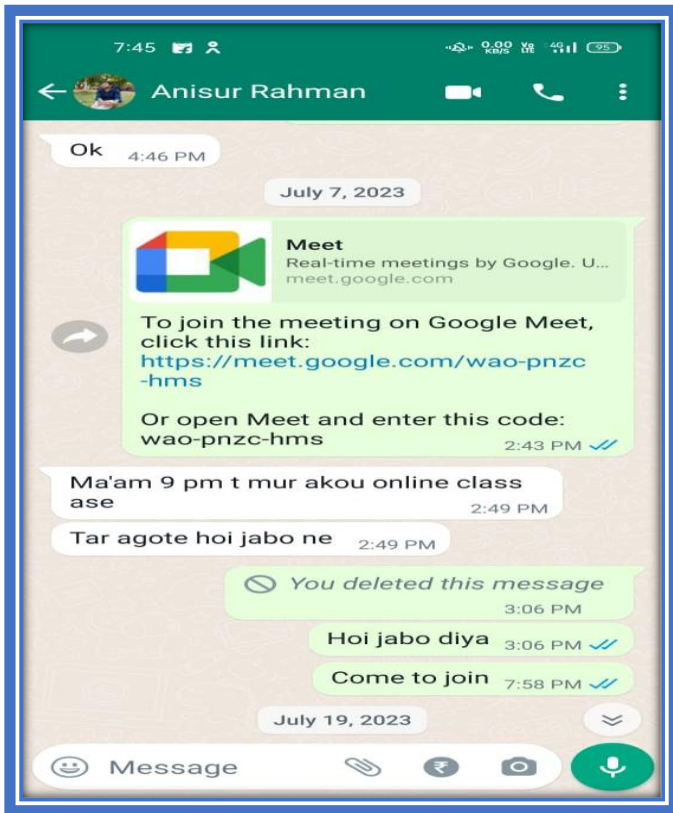
- Limited financial resources restrict the college's ability to provide extensive preparatory materials, tutoring, or access to specialized coaching
