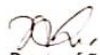

My Sweet Rotten Heritage, the debut theatrical endeavour of the company, was originally produced in 2017 as the performance component of Anasuya's Doctoral degree. Well received by a multicultural audience, Salt Theatre returned to Melbourne in July 2018 for two more successful performances of the play.

The theatre team from Sri Lanka performed the very popular drama "My Sweet Rotten Heritage" at Rampur in Assam's Goalpara district on December 16, 2022. The Sri Lankan theatre group Salt Theatre company led by its director and playwright, Anasuya Subasinghe, performed the 2 hour 30 minutes long play under the Sal Tree Theatre Festival organized at Badurguppa Kalakendra, Rampur.

Salt Theatre company was established by Playwright, director and actor Anasuya Subasinghe as an independent theatre ensemble that engages in practice as research. Composed of an ensemble of young, dynamic performers, salt theatre aims to present theatrical works of high standard that are socially and politically incisive,

creatively challenging, and most certainly entertaining. The 13th edition of the 'Under the Sal Tree' theatre festival is held every year in the middle of Sal tree plantation. It is organized completely under natural settings - with no artificial devices, not even a microphone to enhance the voice of the actors. The organisers use only bamboo and straw to build the stage and the sitting arrangements for the spectators.

My Sweet Rotten Heritage is a political satire that attempts to reimagine this moribund kōlam practice beyond its 'fixed' repertoire, by introducing new masks and narratives familiar to the contemporary spectator. Interlacing political, historical and mythological accounts, and reinterpreting them in today's context, the play explores the performability of kōlam as a 'living', 'evolving' performance practice.
